situate at Aldgate in the said State and all sums of money
payable at my death by any Friendly Society or Lodge or Lodges
and under any Policy or Policies of Assurance on my life to my
sister-in-law EMILY LOUISA SMITH and my daughter ADA CLARICE
CLARK or the survivor of them and if more than one in equal
shares AND I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all the residue of my
real and personal estate to my said sister-in-law EMILY LOUISA
SMITH my said daughter ADA CLARICE CLARK and my two sons
HERBERT HINDE CLARK and WILLIAM CLARENCE CLARK or the survivors
or survivor of them and if more than one in equal shares
PROVIDED ALWAYS that if any child of mine shall die in my life
time leaving a child or children who shall survive me and who
being a son or sons shall attain the age of twenty one years
or being a daughter or daughters shall attain that age or marry
then and in every such case such child or children shall take
and if more than one equally between them the share which his
her or their parent would have taken under this my Will if such
parent had survived me I APPOINT my saod son HERBERT HINDE CLARK
TO BE SOLE Executor of this my Will AND I REVOKE all former Wills
made by me.
