Elliot J. Clark Sr., 86, a retired Army master sergeant, died Wednesday at his home in Virginia Beach, Va.

He was born June 21, 1914, in Springfield, Mass., and lived in Pacific Grove for 30 years before moving to Virginia Beach in 1997.

Mr. Clark served in the U.S. Army for 23 years, retiring with the rank of master sergeant at Fort Ord in 1960.

He is survived by a daughter, Helen C. Johnson of Virginia Beach, Va.; four sons, Elliot J. Clark Jr. of Richmond, Robert T. Clark of Corvallis, Ore., Charles A. Clark of San Diego, and Stephen J. Clark of San Francisco; a sister, Arlene Tellier of Detroit; and seven grandchildren. His wife, Helen, died in 1978.

A graveside service for Mr. Clark will be held at 3 p.m. June 14 at Arlington National Cemetery, Va., where he will be buried alongside his wife.
