79 CASES DEALT WITH.

The unusually long list of 79 cases for breaches of the Traffic Act were dealt with by the Police Magistrate (Dr. A. N. Lewis) in the Hobart Police Court yesterday. (only relevant name transcribed)

Unlicensed Drivers.

The following pleaded guilty to charges of having driven motor vehicles on September 24 without being in possession of licences for the purpose, and were fined the amounts indicated: - William Henry Hastwell (10s, and 8s. costs).
