DAVIES. -On Nov. 7, at hospital Thomas George (Tommy), dearly loved youngest son Mr. & Mrs. Wal Davies, 5 Jervois ave., New Hindmarsh, brother of Laurie. Margaret, Betty and Dorothy, aged 8 years. Sadly missed.

DAVIES. -On Nov. 7. Thomas George (Tommy), dearly loved grandson of Mrs O. E. Butler; aged 8 years. Loved by all

\*Wendy's note: (1) From the dates above I am assuming that Valerie, Judith, Graham and Dene were born after young Thomas (Tommy) died in 1942. (2) Arthur Sommer mentioned above was the husband of Neta Muriel Davies, one of Walter Francis Davies' sisters.

\*Wendy's note: (a) In the death notice inserted in The Advertiser by the parents of young Tommy, the address is given as 5, but 59 appears to be the correct address. (b) In family recollections by Pearl Clark (nee Hastwell) she mentioned that Walter was an electrician who married "Monny" - Pearl has mentioned that at some stage in her childhood Walter and Monny (Monica) lived next door. This would have been after Pearl's uncle Justus Williams and Edrie (nee Davies) moved from Gawler to the vicinity of St Leonards, Adelaide. These Directory entries confirm Walter's occupation of electrician, although (in October 2016) nothing has yet been found of a St Leonard's address for him in the 1920's.
