To Be Verified (2013-05)According to the Garvie family tree (2013, internet), Sarah Hinde was the first child, b. 1832 at Bevington Hill,Liverpool, Lancashire England, of William Hinde (born abt 1796) in England, (unknown death date) and Elizabeth ? (whom he married c.1831 in Liverpool, Lancs, England). According to the 1841 census he was not born in Lancashire. His occupation was butcher. Sarah Hinde died 18 February 1911 at Maylands SA as Sarah Smith. Two other children of William and Elizabeth Hinde are given as Thomas Hinde, b.1834 Liverpool Lancs England and Mary Hinde, b.1837, ditto.

Friday, October 9th, 1852:-The ship Medina, 956 tons, Sandford master, from Liverpool 26th June 1852 with 410 Government emigrants. Wednesday October 20th, passengers per Medina (arrival reported Monday 11th instant).....in steerage—16th ship from England to S.A. with government passengers for 1852; no (?) births and thirteen deaths on the passage, Doctor Martin, surgeon-superintendent.

South Australian Register (Adelaide, SA: 1839 - 1900), Wednesday 13 October 1852, page 1 (12)

TO CAPTAIN SANFORD, SHIP ' MEDINA.' 6th October, 1852. WE, the undersigned, return our sincere thanks to Captain Sanford for his kindness and gentlemanly behaviour to us during our passage. We consider that he has shown us every attention in his power and, has endeavoured to his utmost to make our passage pleasant, comfortable, and agreeable. Again, we return our sincere thanks for his kind and attentive conduct, and wish him every success, health, and happiness. (*Wendy Baker's note: There followed the names of at least 25 male passengers – it was standard practice at the time for letters of thanks to the Captain for his safe delivery of his passengers, to be published in the newspapers. Sadly, the majority of the 13 deaths during this voyage were of very young infants, from diarrhoea, and they were buried at sea.*)
